After logging in, select "*SED Monitoring and Vendor Performance System*".

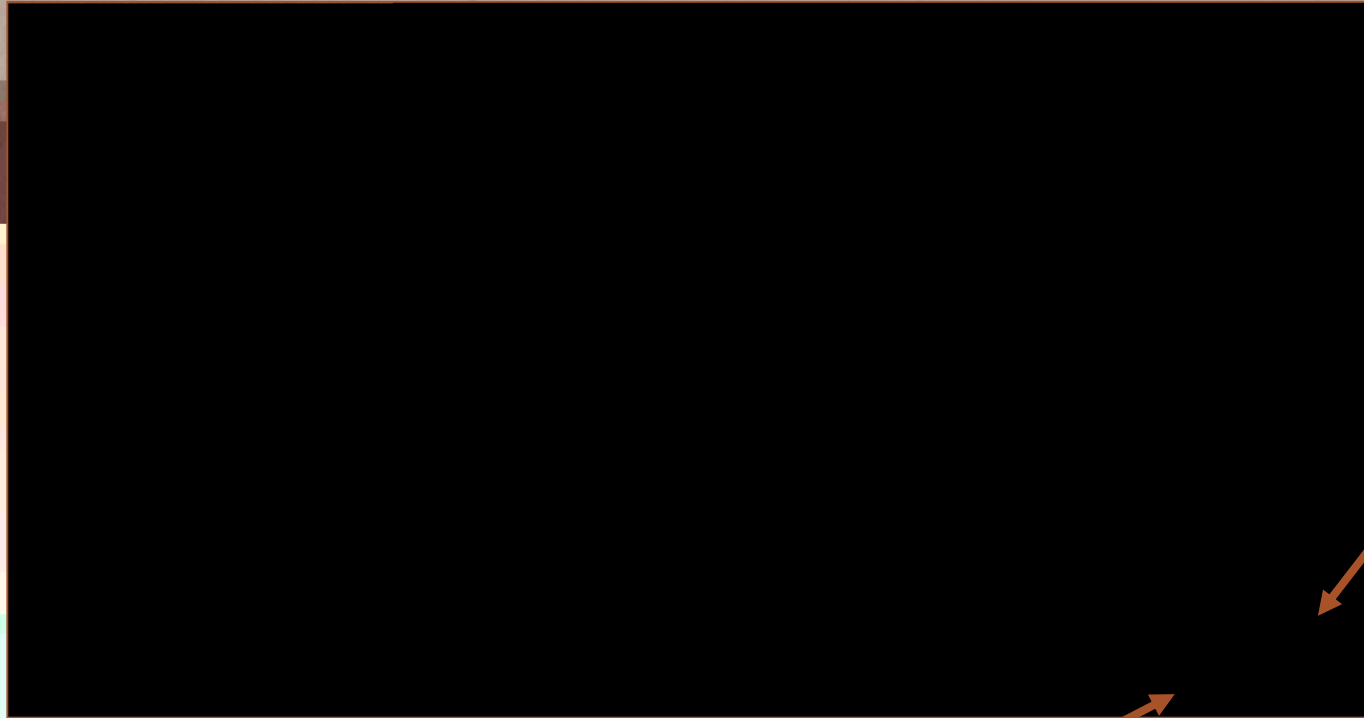


Click on "*View Surveys for Title I School and Community Services*" to access surveys issued from our office.
